Overview

TVN 70 is a high performance network video recorder that is capable of handling up to 400 Mbps of incoming camera bandwidth or up to 128 camera channels. It offers up to 16 internal hard disks that can be set up in a RAID 0/1/5/10 configuration for additional storage redundancy. The unit also offers hardware redundancy options such as hot spare, redundant network cards and redundant power supplies.

Summary of known limitations

The following items are known limitations of TVN 70 firmware 1.0:

When a PSU is defective or not connected, the PSU sounds a buzzer locally but no event is reported or registered in the recorder.

When configuring a lower MTU value than your PC supports by default, the web browser of TVN 70 will not be accessible. The workaround is to lower the MTU settings of the PC to match that of the TVN 70 using these commands at the Command prompt:

```
netsh interface ipv4 set subinterface "Local Area Connection" mtu=xxxx store=persistent
```
