Overview

The TVN 70 series is a Network Video Recorder, capable of managing up to 128 IP camera channels. Firmware 1.2o includes an enhancement and two bug fixes.

Enhancement

- When ONVIF cameras are used in the recorder, you can create a camera name in the recorder. That camera name will then be displayed in the OSD, the webpage of the recorder, and in TruVision Navigator. The name will not be pushed to the camera.

Bug Fix

- Fix for a password issue. In previous firmware live view was not possible when using a 16-character password.
- Fix for an issue with upgrading the firmware when HTTPS is enabled.
