Summary of new features and key enhancements

Settings window

- Import/Export address book was renamed to Import/Export Navigator and moved from the Device node context menu to the Server tab in Settings.
- Access Portal (TruPortal email notifications for any event) and Device On/Off Line (notification for a device tree item going on or offline) checkboxes were added to the Notifications tab in Settings.

- A group summary page and Force Logout button (allows an Administrator to log out a user immediately) were added under the Groups and Users tab in Settings.
- An Object Counting (number of entries, exits, and occupants) notification feature was added under the Logical Event Filtering tab in Settings.
- A Select All checkbox was added to Permissions and Logical Event Filter VCA alarms.
- Import/Export of the address book/Navigator date now includes access control panels, Web pages, and logical views.

Navigator main menu

- New Bookmark Manager was added under the Navigator main menu. This window is a central location that contains all device-level bookmarks.
- The TruVision Device Manager was added to the Navigator main menu.
 - Searches for and finds online Interlogix devices such as IP cameras, DVRs, NVRs, encoders, decoders, IFS switches, and TruPortal access panels.
 - o Supports adding devices manually via the Device Manager interface.
 - Provides a New System Setup Wizard for setting up new devices that have not previously been connected to the network.
 - Permits activation of an inactive device.
 - Provides firmware upgrade capabilities by connecting to the Interlogix firmware server.
 - o Includes tools to perform the following tasks:
 - Change IP address
 - Reset password
 - Manual firmware update
 - Link to storage calculator
 - Device configuration backup and restore
 - Upload camera information
 - Change password
- The Open Exported Video function was moved to the Navigator main menu.

Navigator panel

• The number of connected streams was added to network statistics.

• Reinstate, Lockout, and Unlock All Doors functions were added to the Access Control context menu.

Viewer panel

- Object counting statistics and on-screen counter were added to the video tile context menu for supported cameras.
- Triggerable outputs from both recorders and cameras can be added to maps in theViewer Panel. They can be activated/deactivated by double-clicking on the trigger icon.
- Doors can be opened from maps in theViewer Panel by double-clicking on the door icon.
- Maps can be dragged into other maps and can then be launched from theViewer Panel by double-clicking on the map icon.
- Websites can be dragged into maps and can then be launched from theViewer Panel by double-clicking on the website icon.
- In Maps, associated items can be easily identified by Alt-clicking on an icon. Alt-clicking on a recorder icon highlights its cameras. Alt-clicking on a camera icon highlights its recorder. Alt-clicking a TruPortal icon highlights the doors it controls. Alt-clicking a door highlights its TruPortal panel.
- Ability to add bookmarks to timeline video, edit bookmark information, and export bookmarks with video sent to the Collector.
- Six new custom views were added.
- On-screen display for supported thermal cameras was added.

Summary of bugs fixed

- Fixed an issue where device search did not work unless folders were expanded.
- Fixed an issue with clip playback from dewarped views.
- Fixed an issue where moving the Viewer's right resizer caused screen artifacts on Ultra HD displays.
- Removed the requirement to restart services after the user makes a change in the Settings window.
- Fixed an issue with password length after encryption. After upgrading to 7.0 or later, there was not enough field length to accommodate the encrypted password.
- Fixed an issue with user deletion if the user belongs to a group.
- Backward compatibility was added for export and import of the device list.

- Fixed an issue with Navigator processes running in the background if they are terminated.
- Fixed an issue with devices getting being shown incorrectly as online or offline by extending the ping timeout from 120 ms to 3 sec.

Summary of limitations

- A device may appear offline while verifying credentials due to bad networks or timeout.
- Bookmarks do not appear in the TruVision Navigator Player if the file that is exported is from a country that uses a "," instead of an "." in their numbering scheme.
- The TVR45HD plug-in conflicts with the TVN22 if both are on installed in Navigator.
- An object counting camera must have an SD card installed and be installed in the Navigator tree as a standalone camera in order to use the new features in Navigator.
- The automatic firmware upgrade feature is not available for IFS switches or TruPortal systems.
- On some computers, the Client Download HTML page may be rendered as raw HTML instead of a formatted page. The fix is to replace the server name in the URL with the server IP address.
- The TVR 15HD web plugin needs to be installed manually as it is not compatible with other recorders.
- SQL Server is no longer supported in Windows XP and Windows 2003 Server due to Microsoft's decision to end-of-life those products. When upgrading an existing TruNav SQL Server system on those Windows platforms, the database will be converted to the "Internal Database" format used by Navigator.
- For TVN 21 (FW 3.1), TVN 22, and TVR 15HD:
 - The user needs to search for Alarms and cannot search for intrusion events.
 - The intrusion events are reported in the Notifier but no cameras are linked to the events.
- Legacy devices are still present but are no longer being supported.
