

# TruVision Navigator 9.0 Licensing Addendum



### Overview

This document describes TruVision Navigator 9.0 licensing features.

A 7-day trial period for the licensed features is activated upon initial installation or an upgrade of the Navigator software. During the trial period, the number of days remaining in the trial are shown in a Warning dialog that appears after launching Navigator, and in ToolTips. Select **Don't warn me again** to disable the warning notification.

**Note:** The trial period is 30 days on computers where a previous version of TruVision Navigator was installed.




After the trial period expires, licensed features icons in the Navigator panel appear with a yellow icon to indicate that the features are disabled. When this occurs, a permanent license must be obtained to activate the licensed features.




When less than seven days are left in the trial period, a dialog box appears after launching Navigator. After the trial period expires, licensed features icons in the Navigator panel appear with a yellow icon to indicate that the features are disabled. After this occurs, a permanent license must be obtained from Interlogix customer support or an authorized Interlogix channel partner.

# **Activating a license**


To activate the licensed features, a license key must be obtained from Interlogix. The user activating a Navigator license must be logged in as an Administrator.

#### To activate a license:


1. Click on the Navigator main menu button and select Licensing.




2. The Licensed Features window appears. Click Update License.



3. The Update License window appears. Contact Interlogix and obtain a license key. The customer key must be provided to Interlogix to obtain a license key.



4. Type or cut and paste the license key into the License Key field.



5. When a valid license is entered, the **OK** button is activated. Click **OK** to store the license key. The licensed features appear in the Navigator panel with activated icons.

# License tampering

Changing a computer's date affects licensing:

- Changing to a previous date during the trial period invalidates and locks the licensed features. If this occurs, a permanent license must be obtained to activate the licensed features.
- Changing to a future date during the trial period reduces the number of days available to evaluate the licensed features.
